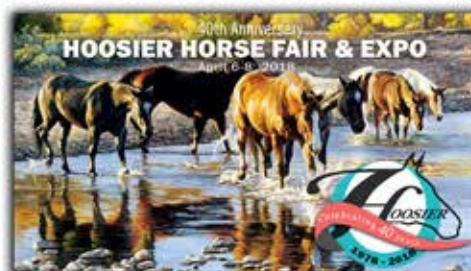
This year, in an ongoing effort to draw the finest artists in the country, the Hoosier Horse Fair & Expo is offering cash prizes.

Categories for the show include acrylic, colored pencil, mixed media, sculpture, wearable art, oil, pastel, pencil/charcoal, photography, and watercolor. Each division is judged by professionals, with top honor going to Best of Show. Expo attendees are encouraged to vote for their favorite piece of art, and the most popular vote will be presented with the "People's Choice Award." becoming the 2019 image of the HHF & E.

Horses have been the icons of civilization throughout history, with mankind depending upon them for farming, transportation, war, and exploration. Horses have been depicted in art throughout the ages, too, often seen in larger-than-life statues. In fact, there is urban legend that soldiers seen astride in statues are thought to have died during battle if the horse is rearing. The soldier was wounded in battle if one of the horse's front legs is lifted up, and if all four hooves are on the ground, the soldier died outside of battle.
