PARADE OF BREEDS

Our signature events at the Hoosier Horse Fair & Expo, Breed Showcase and Parade of Stallions, have now been combined to be known as The Parade of Breeds and will continue to be a crowd favorite. With thousands of spectators packing the bleachers to enjoy the performance of various breeds and disciplines, it is a prime opportunity to educate and entertain the attendees.

Featuring your horse at the HHF&E is a major marketing showcase opportunity for stallions and breed registries. The Parade of Breeds is open to all breeds. More than 20,000 spectators attended the HHF&E and has become one of the top 3-day equine events in the United States.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- Applications and Entry Fees are due by April 2, 2019
- High-resolution photo of the horse must be submitted electronically
- Groups representing the national or state organizations will be given first considerations
- Each equine participant needs to provide a 4 (four) minute script
- Event management reserves the right to limit the number to 2 (two) equines per breed
- Event management reserves the right to determine the eligibility of any breed or stallion participant in The Parade of Breeds and to refuse any entry should it prove to be detrimental to the safety and welfare to other.

PARADE OF BREEDS PARTICIPANTS RECEIVE THE FOLLOWING:

- One horse stall and one adjoining stall for tack
- Three presentations (once per day) during The Parade of Breeds
- Two weekend badges and one parking pass
